

Isa 57:14

"Build up, build up, prepare the road! Remove the obstacles out of the way of my people."

Isa 61:1

The most important question is not why but how should we respond?

DEDICATE YOURSELF TO GOD

Joshua 3:5 Then Joshua said to the people, "Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the LORD will do wonders among you."

GOD CAN SET THE CAPTIVES FREE FROM DISAPPOINTMENT AS WE REFUSE TO LET IT TRIP US UP (MATT 11v6)

...who does not stumble (NIV)
...not offended (NKJV)
...do not fall away (NLT)

The word most frequently translated "offend" in the King James Version is "skandalizō"

Matt 5v29-30, 11v6, 13v41, 18v6, Rom 14v21, 16v17

Offended=scandalised

trapped in a bait, a bent stick with bait fastened which the animal strikes and springs the trap

"And blessed [joyful, favoured by God] is he who does not take offense at Me [accepting Me as the Messiah and trusting confidently in My message of salvation]." Amplified Bible

How should we respond?

Asaph: Psalm 73:17 when I went into the temple, then I understood their end.....

- Jesus: Luke 9:49-50 'someone driving out demons in your name and we tried to stop him, because he is not one of us."
- Paul: Phil 1:18-19 don't worry the gospel is still being preached whatever their motives



John should have known the work of the Messiah,

based on *Isa* 35:5-6 which predicts EXACTLY what Jesus is now doing



- Ruth 1:20-21 Mara = bitter
- Job 42v1-2 no plan thwarted
- Acts 8v1-4 persecution leads to expansion
- Acts 15 "sharp disagreement" which resulted in kingdom expansion
