Eph 4:17-24 "be made new in the attitude of your mind"


Righteousness: right thinking in the area of our identity



How do we do this?


How can we be made new in the attitudes of our mind?

We're driven to achieve more to make ourselves acceptable to others and ourselves.




4. Acceptance

The vicious cycle (of grief)


2. Identity


Our sense of significance is dependent on what we achieve, so we push on.



1. Achievement (activity)


We achieve to provide ourselves with an identity.


Resources constantly renewed through dependence on God (Ephesians 2:7)
