Staying Focused on God means **EMBRACING GOD'S PURPOSES**

We need to understand a little bit of history to embrace Gods purposes:

- Cyrus the Great (around 600 BC) figures in the Hebrew Bible as the deliverer of the Jews.
- He is mentioned 23 times by name and alluded to several times more.
- (Isa 44:23: 45:8, 45:1-7). Isaiah's message of deliverance from bondage: God chooses Cyrus, a foreign ruler, to set God's people free.

The consistent decleration of the bible is that God is in control, despite what we may think at times

- Job 42:2-4 "no plan of yours can be thwarted"
- **Psalm 33:11** "the plans of the Lord stand firm forever, the purposes of his heart through all generations"
- Eccles 3:1-10 "he makes everything beautiful in its time"

Conclusion: So what do we do in response?

"Keep your eyes on Jesus, who both began and finished this race we're in. Study how he did it.
