- Love the Lord (RELATIONSHIP)
- Love your neighbour (RELATIONSHIP).

#### Commandments Addressing Relationship with Others

- 5. Honour parents
- 6. Do not murder
- 7. Do not commit adultery
- 8. Do not steal
- 9. Do not give false testimony
- 10. Do not covet



## Jesus showed it's not just outward observance he's interested in:

#### Matthew 5:21-22 The Message

"You're familiar with the command to the ancients, 'Do not murder.' I'm telling you that anyone who is so much as angry with a brother or sister is guilty of murder. Carelessly call a brother 'idiot!' and you just might find yourself hauled into court. Thoughtlessly yell 'stupid!' at a sister and you are on the brink of hellfire. The simple moral fact is that words kill."



### Matthew 5:27-28 The Message

"You know the next commandment pretty well, too: 'Don't go to bed with another's spouse.' But don't think you've preserved your virtue simply by staying out of bed. Your heart can be corrupted by lust even quicker than your body. Those ogling looks you think nobody notices—they also corrupt."
