



The Truth About My Father God

I say NO to the lie that Father God:

is distant and not interested in me

is grumpy and strict

is too busy for me or not there for me

is angry or never happy with what I do

I say YES to the truth that Father God:

is close to me and cares for me (Psalm 139:1-18)

loves me and is kind all the time (Psalm 103:8-14)

is always there for me and is full of joy and love (Hebrews 13:5; Zephaniah 3:17)

is patient and slow to get cross (Exodus 34:6; 2 Peter 3:9; Psalm 147:11)



The Truth About My Father God

I say NO to the lie that Father God:

is mean and cruel

doesn't want me to have fun

won't forgive me

is looking for when I get things wrong

I say YES to the truth that Father God:

is loving and protects me

(Isaiah 42:3; Psalm 18:2)

wants me to have the best life

(John 10:10; Romans 12:1-2)

is always kind and forgives me

(Psalm 130:1-4; Luke 15:17-24)

is proud of me

(Romans 8:28; Hebrews 12:5-11)
