Putting 1 Sam 15 & 16 into context




#### 1 Samuel 15:

- God commands Saul, the king of Israel, to completely destroy the Amalekites and their possessions.
- Saul defeats the Amalekites but spares their king, Agag, and keeps the best of the livestock.
- Samuel confronts Saul for disobeying God's command and declares that God has rejected him as king.
- Saul admits his wrongdoing but only out of fear of losing his kingdom.
- Samuel kills Agag, and Saul's disobedience leads to God regretting making him king.

### 1 Samuel 16:

- God instructs Samuel to anoint a new king from the house of Jesse in Bethlehem.
- Samuel goes to Jesse's house and sees his sons, but God chooses David, the youngest son and a shepherd.
- David is anointed in the presence of his family.
- The Spirit of the Lord comes upon David from that day forward, but Saul remains troubled by an evil spirit. (rebellion=witchcraft)
- David is brought into Saul's service to play the harp and soothe him when the evil spirit troubles him.

### HOW DO WE GET PAST OUR PAST?

- We get past our past when we REDEFINE OUR PAST
- •We get past our past when we REBUILD OUR PRESENT

1 Sam 16:1

"so fill your flask with olive oil and go to Bethlehem"



- Samuel will anoint David just as Samuel had anointed Saul (1 Samuel 10:1). <u>NOT</u> take possession of the throne for many years.
- David's first anointing = spiritual one. David was anointed a second time, after the death of Saul (2 Samuel 1:7).
- To anoint someone is to pour oil on their body, usually the head, to signify that the person is set apart for God's purpose.
- The first occurrence of someone being anointed in the Bible is Aaron the high priest (Exodus 29:7).



- Samuel's mistake was that he wasn't seeing form Gods perspective.
- Samuel assumed his viewpoint was the same as Gods and so he live in regret of the past but also was in danger of missing Gods work in the present.
- Samuel assumed that by looking on the outside, external God could choose the next king.



- Profound use of irony, suspense, and reversal of expectations-plays upon the contrast between <u>seeing</u> and <u>hearing</u>.
- The chapter's key word "see" (h)r) is again in play, especially in v. 7, where it occurs five times.
- The problem is that Samuel is relying on his human sense of vision, which will not do for the work of God.
- 1 Sam 9:19, Samuel = "seer," literally a "see-er" (h)ero). BUT
  1 Sam 16:3 emphasizes, Samuel's job was not so much to judge by
  what he sees as to listen and obey God:

"you shall anoint for me the one whom I name to you." NKJV



### WHY IS THIS SO IMPORTANT FOR REBUILDING OUR PRESENT?

God sees and hears the secret, private Heb 4:12-13

**TRAINING** not trying - Hebrews 12:11





Trying is an attempt to do the right thing by putting in some effort in the moment.

Training is a commitment to <u>strategic habits</u> to do before the moment that equips you to do the right thing in the moment

### TRAINING NOT TRYING

1 Corinthians 9:25-27 (NLT)

"All athletes are disciplined in their training..... I discipline my body like an athlete, training it to do what it should...".

1 Timothy 4:7-8 (NLT)

"train yourself to be godly."



- Behaviour change doesn't generally work IDENTITY CHANGE is what matters
- THIS IS within your ability control because you can choose what you believe and the habits you form.
