Greek word = 'hupomoné'

Root words

hypó, which means "under"

ménō which means "remain, endure"

**God wants us to "remain (endure) under" Him
in the challenges we face in life.**

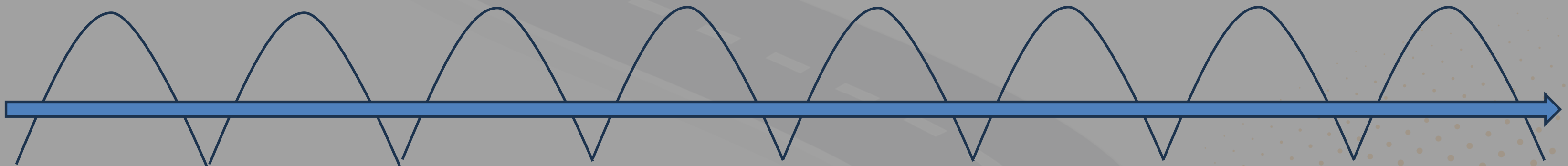
