

Then I prayed, "Hear us, our God, for we are being mocked. May their scoffing fall back on their own heads, and may they themselves become captives in a foreign land! Do not ignore their guilt. Do not blot out their sins, for they have provoked you to anger here in front of the builders." **Nehemiah 4:4**

1. Look Up!


Adoration and worship-goes past our feelings


3. Look At!

- Family They realised that marriage and the sabbath needed protecting -they had become too relaxed about them both
- Tithing for Gods work they didn't have a lot but believed if they gave God would provide (Matthew 6:33)

The law of Moses was unable to save us because of the weakness of our sinful nature. So God did what the law could not do. He sent his own Son in a body like the bodies we sinners have. And in that body God declared an end to sin's control over us by giving his Son as a sacrifice for our sins **Romans 8:3**
