## "DEDICATION"

**Dedication** is simply defined as commitment.

You commit something to someone. It is to be readily available for use for something or someone. We dedicate ourselves to people and a cause and we dedicate things to people



## WHY WAS THE TEMPLE AND WALL DEDICATED?

> As a formal way of committing it to God for His use and keeping it holy. This makes Dedication a spiritual form of transference of ownership to God.
